The 4th of July is always a blast at camp complete with a beach party and carnival on the quad. Everyone gets dressed up in their best red, white, and blue apparel.



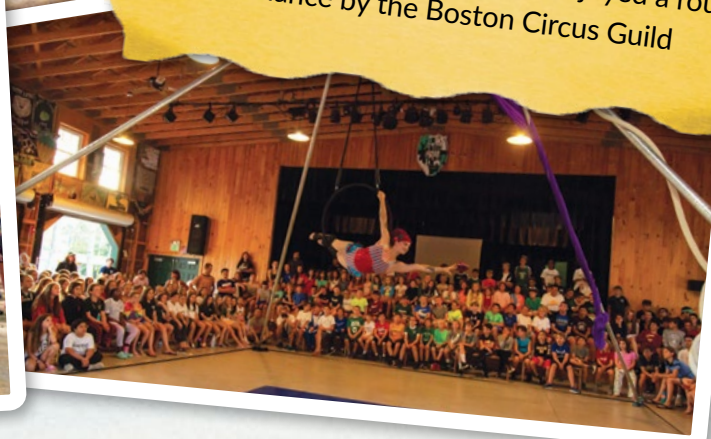
## Opening Day

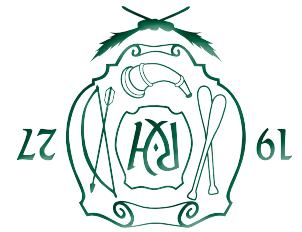
